
Step 1. Connect your wireless router





- 1. Connect one end of the **coax cable** into an available wall outlet in your home and the other end into the wireless router.
- 2. Plug the power cord into the wireless router.
- **3.** Allow the wireless router to boot fully and connect to the network. When all lights on the wireless router are solid and no longer flashing, your router is connected.
- Helpful Hint: If you would like to directly connect your computer to your wireless router, use the Ethernet cable provided and plug it from your wireless router to your computer.

Step 2. Accessing your default wireless router settings



The WOW!® technician has already activated your wireless router. See steps below to locate your wireless router's Network Name and Password.

- Locate the default Network Name (SSID) and Password (Pre-Shared Key) on a label on the side or bottom panel of your wireless router.
- Look for the default Network Name (SSID) in your WiFi settings and connect your device using the default Password (Pre-Shared Key).
- To customize your Network Name (SSID) and Password (Pre-Shared Key), see next step.

Step 3 (optional). Customize your Network Name and Password

- 1. In your browser type 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.100.1–this is the device administration page address.
- 2. Log in leaving the Username and Password blank.
- 3. Go to the Wireless tab to edit default Network Names for the 2.4GHz and 5GHz frequencies.
- **4.** Click the Save button in the bottom right corner to set your Network Names.
- **5.** To update your Password on both frequencies visit the **Security** tab under the **Wireless** section, type your desired Password, and save your changes.



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
